"Blessed are those whose strength is in you, whose hearts are set on pilgrimage." (Psalm 84:5)

All things work for good for those who love God!

Most of the Ethiopians are Orthodox Christians, as the Ethiopian Church is a sister Church of other Orthodox Churches and the Catholic Church.

However, its congregation faced persecution during the communism era that lasted for a long time.

In 1979, Mangisto, the communist president learned that attending the Holy Liturgy and receiving the Holy Communion was the direct link of the Christians to their faith. So he ordered for cars not to be used on Sundays. Most of the Christians lived hours away from the churches and this order moved their hearts to hold fast to attending the Holy Liturgy. So the streets were filled, from as early as 5 a.m. Some of the people walked for long hours to attend the Holy Liturgy from the beginning. Many of those who were not keen to attend or attended the Holy Liturgy late, started making it earlier to enjoy it. Therefore, the cramp conditions moved the people's hearts and there was a spiritual movement and more keenness to receive Holy Communion.

Praying is the greatest thing on Earth because it is a direct dialogue with God. However, the most important is the Holy Liturgy because it is a gathering around the Body of Christ. Christ who offered Himself for His children on the altar so that they may unite with Him and Him in them.

The church is filled with the angels and the saints, from the beginning of the Holy Liturgy, to enjoy their presence around Christ. So do not delay in joining them in this great festival, knowing that prayers prepare you to accept Christ inside you; as they cleanse you from the worldly lusts, make you integrate with the heavenly hosts, increase your affections to Christ and finally receive His Holy Body and precious Blood. Amen.

New Year's Day - Solemnity of the Mother of God Homily of Pope Francis was on how to lead a faith-filled 2018. Three highlights to help incorporate God into your daily life.

- 1. Set aside a moment of silence each day to be with God. This will help us to "keep our freedom from being corroded by the banality of consumerism, the blare of commercials, the stream of empty words and overpowering waves of empty chatter and loud shouting."
- 2. Leave behind life's useless baggage and rediscover what really matters. "If we want to go forward, we need to turn back: to begin anew from the crib, from the Mother who holds God in her arms. Devotion to Mary is not spiritual etiquette; it is a requirement of the Christian life."
- 3. Give everything over to God. "Hopes and worries, light and darkness: all these things dwelt in the heart of Mary. What did she do? She pondered them, that is to say she dwelt on them, with God, in her heart. She held nothing back; she locked nothing within out of self-pity of resentment...We keep things when we hand them over: by not letting our lives become prey to fear, distress or superstition, by not closing our hearts or trying to forget, but by turning everything into a dialogue with God."
