"Deliver me, O Lord, from evil men; Preserve me from violent men." (Psalms 140:1)

Many complain about the injustice in this world. I read this verse from the Old Testament, "Though a sinner does evil a hundred times, and his days are prolonged, yet I surely know that it will be well with those who fear God, who fear before Him." (Ecclesiastes 8:12)

And found this interpretation: Sometimes a person as part of human nature asks, 'Why do you let unjust

people oppress and trouble us, God? What is the fault of the oppressed?

God answers: Be patient, even if the unjust person continues with his oppression. There is goodness & benefit for those who fear the Lord.

A verse says, "But the more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and grew." (Exodus 1:12). That is why a faithful person should expect more blessings when afflicted especially if they cannot change the situation and bear it patiently. All those who bore injustice through no fault of their own, no matter how long it has gone on, God takes them away from under this pressure to the light and lifts them up in a miraculous way that no one can imagine. Just like when God brought out Joseph (in

Egypt) from the depth of humiliation (prison) to the

greatest heights. God does not leave anyone who

undergoes injustice in any form.

When oppressed and troubled, some people may forget God and curse Him, but don't ever lean towards evil. David, the prophet once said that God will not allow the wicked to go unpunished, lest the righteous lose their faith. That is why a person should keep holding on to His goodness and trust that the Lord will lift him up in the fullness of time, i.e. in the right time. Amen.

<u>Diocesan Event:</u> Major relic of Saint Francis Xavier to visit the Archdiocese of Toronto *Monday, December 11, 2017*

A first-degree relic of missionary Saint Francis Xavier is coming to the Archdiocese of Toronto, January 12-14, 2018. The forearm of the saint, permanently displayed at the Church of the Gesù in Rome, will be in Canada from December 29 — February 2, as part of a 14-city Canadian visit. In our archdiocese, the relic will be hosted by St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica (Jan. 12), St. Francis Xavier Church, Mississauga (Jan. 13) and Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, Toronto (January 14). More information about the visit and a full schedule of events can be found at: www.cco.ca/relic

Organizers believe this is the first time the relic has been on Canadian soil. The body of St. Francis Xavier, which is buried in Goa, India, as well as the relic of his arm, are incorrupt—they have not experienced natural decay since his death in 1552. Organizers expect close to 100,000 people will visit the various events across the country—the same number of people it is believed Francis baptized with his right arm and hand.
