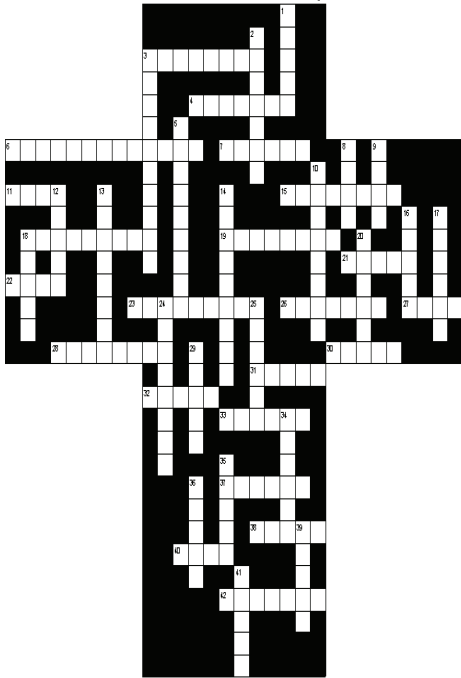

The 26th Annual Lift Jesus Higher Rally

On Saturday March 3, 2018 was "Fire on the Earth" (Luke 12:49) and featured Ralph Martin and Sr. Ann Shields of Renewal Ministries and keynote guest speaker Patti Mansfield. The day began with the rosary in honour of "Our Lady of the Cape" and followed with a series of compelling talks, powerful Christian praise music, inspiring personal testimonials, a Divine Mercy celebration, Eucharistic procession and prayer ministry for healing and empowerment. The day wrapped up with a beautiful mass celebrated by His Eminence Thomas Cardinal Collins and thousands of enthusiastic delegates (clergy and laity) from all over Ontario. A separate youth event (13-18 years) in an adjacent hall featured great music, dynamic talks, inspirational skits and an uplifting youth mass celebrated by Bishop Scott McCaig.

The urgent message at the rally pointed to the dangers of a growing secularism in Canada that is pervading our culture and consistently undermining the core values and belief system of Christianity. Delegates were cautioned not to water-down one's faith and 'tip-toe' around hot button issues such as abortion, same-sex marriage and euthanasia in a misguided effort at political correctness. We were urged to embrace Our Lady's messages of Fatima to repent of our sins and to offer sacrifices for the conversion of sinners. Delegates were told that the salvation of our family members and friends may very well depend on our willingness to deepen our prayer lives, fast and sacrifice, and open ourselves to the power of the Holy Spirit. Sober reminders of the reality of Satan, sin and hell were strongly reinforced by the Cardinal in his homily in which he encouraged a personal Lenten exercise to examine our behaviours and intentions and honestly identify "which 'god' is sitting on our throne." He boldly proclaimed that the 10 Commandments are not "mere suggestions"!
