Hospital boat named 'Pope Francis':

Belem, Brazil, Aug 20, 2019 / 09:30 am (CNA).- A hospital boat named the "Pope Francis" set sail this week in the Amazon River to bring medical care to rural populations.

"Just as Jesus, who appeared walking on water, calmed the storm and to exercise it often," Pope Francis said Aug. 18. and strengthened the faith of the disciples, this boat will bring spiritual comfort and calm to the worries of needy men and women, abandoned to their fate," Pope Francis said in a letter sent to mark the ship's launch Aug. 17 in Belem, Brazil.

"In addition to being a beautiful concrete gesture in view of the Synod of Bishops for Amazon, this river hospital is above all a response to the Lord's mandate, who continues to send His disciples to proclaim the Kingdom of God and to heal the sick," the pope said, according to Vatican News.

The hospital boat is the initiative of the Fraternity of Saint Francis of Assisi in the Providence of God in partnership with their local diocese and the Brazilian government.

The Brazilian Franciscans were inspired to create the floating hospital when Pope Francis visited their healthcare facility during World Youth Day in Rio de Janeiro in 2013. During the visit, the pope encouraged Friar Francisco Belotti to expand his religious order's charitable works into the Amazon region.

The boat, 32 meters in length, contains an operating room and analysis laboratory, and is able to provide a range of medical services, including X-rays, vaccinations, electrocardiogram, mammograms, and ultrasounds. The hospital began treating its first patients Aug. 18.

"Barco Hospital Papa Francisco" will travel along the Amazon River to reach people who live in communities in the Amazon only accessible by river. It is staffed by 20 medical volunteers, 10 crew members, and a Franciscan boat director for each 10-day voyage.

Pope Francis, who has often spoken of the Church as a "field hospital," added that the Church can also now be seen as a "hospital on the water." The pope connected the hospital boat's launch to the upcoming Special Synod of Bishops from the Pan-Amazonian region, to be held at the Vatican Oct. 6-27. The synod's working document, entitled "Amazonia: New Paths for the the face of ever new needs that are looming in the world, there Church and for an Integral Ecology," discusses the environmental and economic problems faced by Amazonian communities and pastoral approaches to the region.

"The Church cannot but worry about the integral salvation of the human person, which involves promoting the culture of indigenous peoples, talking about their vital needs, accompanying

movements and joining forces to defend their rights," the synod working document states.

Discover the beauty of adoration:

"I invite everyone to discover the beauty of the prayer of adoration

Adoration of God in prayer is necessary to allow the fire of love that Jesus brought to the earth to envelop our entire existence, the pope explained. In his Angelus address, the pope reflected upon this Sunday's Gospel from Luke in which Jesus says to his disciples, "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!"

"These words are intended to help the disciples to abandon any attitude of laziness, apathy, indifference and closure to welcome the fire of God's love; that love which, as Saint Paul reminds us, 'has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit," Pope Francis said.

"Jesus reveals to his friends, and also to us, his most ardent desire: to bring to earth the fire of the Father's love, which kindles life and through which man is saved," he said.

The Gospel is a limitless fire that saves and changes the world beginning with a change inside the heart of each person, Francis said. For this, he explained, it is necessary to adore God and serve others.

"It is a question of not living in a hypocritical way, but of being willing to pay the price for coherent choices - this is the attitude that each of us should look for in life: consistency - paying the price to be consistent with the Gospel," Pope Francis said.

"It is good to say that we are Christians, but above all we must be Christians in concrete situations, bearing witness to the Gospel which is essentially love for God and for our brothers," he said.

Pope Francis pointed to the example of communities and groups of young people who dedicate their summers to service to others. The pope said that he admires those who devote themselves to the service of the sick, the poor, and people with disabilities.

"To live according to the spirit of the Gospel it is necessary that, in are disciples of Christ who know how to respond with new initiatives of charity," he said.

"May Mary Most Holy help us to let our hearts be purified by the fire brought by Jesus and to spread it with our lives through decisive and courageous choices," Pope Francis said.
