The Witness of a faith filled life:

When my daughter invited me to participate in the *40 days for Life campaign* scheduled for the first Friday in November outside a London, Ontario hospital where abortions are regularly performed, I wasn't prepared for how profoundly the experience might impact me

We were visiting our daughter's family to assist with harvest activities on the farm, when out of the blue my daughter asked her Dad to watch the baby so we "girls" (me, my daughter and her two year old toddler) could participate in the 40 DAYS for life in a prayer vigil to "end abortion" --happening outside the hospital grounds at a busy intersection in London.

When I arrived at the campaign site with my daughter and her 2 year old daughter, I was immediately struck by two realities--(1) it was freezing cold and, this would surely be the longest hour of my life!--and,(2) the women, already on location, parading up and down the boulevard with anti-abortion placards around their necks, looked more like political protesters than prayer warriors.

At that moment, my daughter reached into her knapsack and took out a very small pink baby blanket, spread it on the cold, wet ground and immediately fell to her knees, inviting the other ladies to join in the rosary. I dutifully dropped to my knees beside my daughter, tears streaming down my cheeks, struck by this bold demonstration of faith! As we prayed the rosary aloud, my granddaughter pressed her little body against her Mommy and Nana's knees, occasionally lifting her head to gaze lovingly into her Mommy's eyes. The three of us, huddled together on our knees, must have been quite the sight for passers-by!

At first, my back and knees ached, as the chill of the cold soil penetrated through the flimsy blanket...then, humbled and overwhelmed with gratitude for the witness of faith of the my daughter and my granddaughter, I was strangely soothed by the mantra of the "Hail Mary's" and soon forgot how cold and uncomfortable I was! What began as a protest march had been transformed into a moment of deep prayer. Time stood still, and the petitions to Mother Mary muted the sounds of traffic and neutralized the effects of the unseasonably cold temperatures.

My heart soared as I embraced this small penance in joyful wonder

at how life had come full circle--my children and grandchildren were now mentoring me in faith! The joy that welled up in my heart reminded me of the day my daughter (and her sister and brother) were born, the miracle of new life, and the cherished realization that *every* life is precious...renewing my hope that the power of simple, heartfelt prayers like those uttered by my family that cold autumn morning, truly have the power to transform the world! I am sorry that it has taken me this long to appreciate the importance of a public prayer witness to put an end to the evil of abortion--but I am forever grateful for my daughter's shining example of faith that has led me to consider this important prayer ministry. St. Albert the Great November 15

St. Albert the Great is a Doctor of the Church and the patron saint of scientists. The native German joined the newly formed Order of Preachers (Dominicans) in the early 13th century. He earned a doctorate from the University of Paris and taught theology there and in Cologne, Germany.

Albert became known as "Great" because of his intellectual abilities; he was a respected philosopher, scientist, theologian and teacher, and was well-versed in Arabic culture. One of his students, who later became a great friend and built upon his Scholastic method, was Thomas Aguinas. He died Nov. 15, 1280.

St. Joseph Moscati November 16

On November 16, the Church celebrates the feast of St. Joseph Moscati, the first modern medical doctor to be canonized. Born on July 25, 1880 in Benevento, Italy, he lived out the Gospel through his position as a teacher and physician. There are a number of stories of Dr. Moscati paying close attention to the state of his patient's soul as well as the body, sometimes even bringing the patient back to the sacraments. The Catholic understanding of body and soul clearly informed his understanding of illness and medicine. He saw Confession and Communion as the "first medicine."

He is quoted as once having said, "Remember that you have to deal not only with the bodies but also with the moaning souls coming to you."

Dr. Moscati's holiness and devotion wasn't just limited to his practice. To help the poor, he often donated his medical services or paid for his patients' prescriptions.

St. Joseph Moscati also felt it was important to support priests and those in religious life with his prayers because, as he said: "They are easily forgotten by the living, since Christians often think that they do not need prayers."

He carried a Rosary in his pocket as a reminder throughout his day and as a way to draw him to Our Lady -- and through her, to Jesus -- when he needed to make important decisions.

St. Joseph Moscati died on April 12, 1927 of natural causes in his office between patient appointments. He was beatified on November 16, 1975 by Pope Paul VI and canonized on October 25, 1987 by Pope John Paul II. His body rests in Naples, Italy, in the Church of Gesu Nuovo.
