Saints Joachim and Anne-July 26 Feast Day!

Saints Joachim and Anne hold a special place in Christian tradition as the parents of the Virgin Mary, the mother of Jesus Christ. Though information about them primarily comes from the apocryphal Gospel of James, their story has been cherished and venerated by the faithful for centuries.

The Gospel of James - The Gospel of James, an apocryphal text from the second century, provides the most detailed account of Joachim and Anne's lives. While not included in the canonical scriptures, this gospel offers a narrative that has deeply influenced Christian tradition and iconography.
